



GORDON COLLEGE BOY'S SOCCER CAMP

We hope that you and your child are looking forward to the Gordon College Boy's Soccer Camp this summer. The staff is working hard to prepare for camp and we are excited to get things underway!

Here are a few key pieces of information you need to know at this time:

- **Health Physical:** A report of a physical examination (complete with health history) conducted within the last 24 months as well as an immunization record completed by your doctor will need to be submitted no later than two weeks prior to the start of camp. Gordon does not require that a specific form be used, only that all information is submitted. Doctors will usually mail or fax these upon request.
- **Emergency Contact/Camper Release/Epipen Form:** Each camper is required to have an Emergency Contact, Camper Release, and Epipen (if applicable) Form on file. Please complete these forms and return them no later than two weeks prior to camp.
