

AMY YATES SOFTBALL CAMP
COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The following policies and procedures are an attempt by the Amy Yates Softball Camp to minimize the risk of the spread of the COVID-19 virus while campers and those accompanying the campers attend softball camp. These guidelines do not eliminate the risk the campers and anyone accompanying take on while attending camp. With that being said, for the health and well being of all of those working and attending camp, we ask that all guest adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please do not enter the facility if you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last two weeks or have come in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last month.
- All camp participants and any of those accompanying them check their temperatures prior to leaving their house the day of camp. Anyone having a fever of 100.4 or higher is asked to stay home and not attend the camp. If someone in your household is running a fever as well we ask that the entire household forgo attending camp.
- Anyone showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, and fatigue please do not attend.
- At all possible times, we ask that everyone adhere to the recommended 6 feet social distancing guidelines.
- Families limit the number of those attending camp as possible.
- All players, coaches, and fans bring personal hand sanitizer and wash hands frequently.
- All participants (guardian for those under legal age) must sign this form as a waiver to acknowledge their assumption of risk in attending camp.

What to expect as participants and spectators:

- Bleachers should not be used, fans are encouraged to bring their own chairs for comfort. Face coverings are recommended to be worn when within 6 feet of others and tents or canopies are encouraged to only be shared by household family members.
- Players will be instructed to use space outside of the dugouts and down the fence to be able to socially distance with their teammates during participation in camp.
- High fives, handshakes, and other celebratory physical contact methods are forbidden.
 - Please note: this includes interactions with the camp staff. While handshakes are a common, respectful gesture, please refrain from doing so at this time.
- Sunflower seeds are prohibited.
- When huddling for instruction or in line for a drill, camp participants are expected to remain socially distant.
- There will be no sharing personal equipment. Each player must have their own bat, glove, and batting helmet (batting gloves and catching equipment where needed as well).
- There will be **no group water coolers** provided or allowed for participants. Participants must bring their own water and stay on top of their hydration.

By signing below, I acknowledge the risk in attending softball camp in a shared facility and realize these guidelines do not protect my child against the possibility of contracting COVID-19. I waive liability from Amy Yates Softball Camps and accept these risks.
